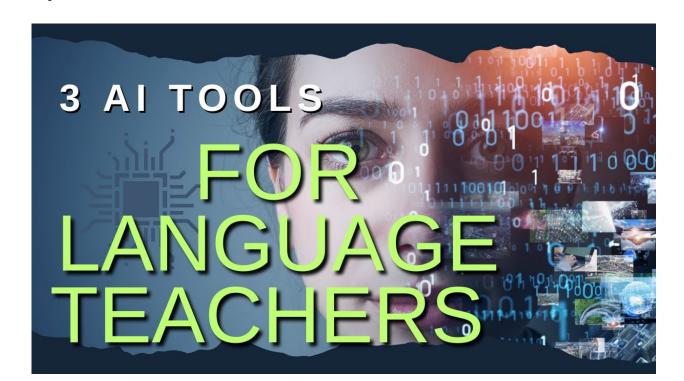


Da nemico ad alleato: integrare l'intelligenza artificiale nelle classi di italiano
